Academic Support		1.4	Action the report and adjust the student's study load accordingly.

Student		2.1	Make an appointment to speak with the Academic Directorate/Program Coordinator (FSP).		
Program Coordinator (FSP/HEP)		2.2	Discuss the reasons for the increase or reduction of the study load and assess the consequences.		
		2.3	If the student is a sponsored student check with the sponsor before any approvals are made.		
		2.4	If the decision to increase or reduce the load is approved update the student systems accordingly.		
Academic Support		2.5	If a reduced load has been approved extend the CoE once it has expired.
